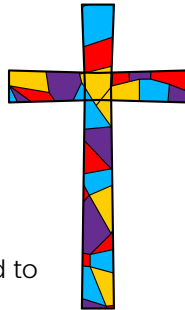

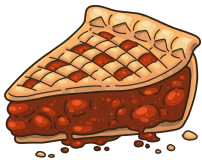

SPRING FUNDRAISER - READ A FUN

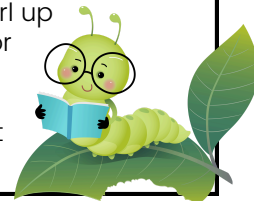
March 1st - March 30th
