There will be a second ordering window held in the spring with two other FLS designs.


HEALTH & SAFETY PROCEDURES

All medication needs to have a medication authorization form completed and submitted to the school office.



- All prescription medication must have the prescription on the medication bottle.
- The school will practice one emergency drill a month (fire, earthquake, or lockdown)
- In the unlikely event of an emergency that requires a full evacuation of our campus, you will pick your child up from the Lacey Community Center, which is our designated Evacuation Assembly Area. (6729 Pacific Ave SE)
