- Keep our teachers in your prayers.

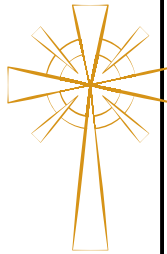
Parents & guardians, thank you for being such a supportive and positive community. It is a joy to be part of this mission with you of educating and raising God's children in faith.

## CHAPEL OFFERING

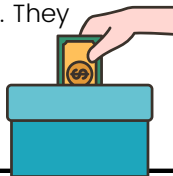
Trimester 3 Chapel Offering will be donated to Lutheran Bible Translators: Rev. Dr. Glenn Fluegge
