Students are to bring all materials to Open House to have ready in their lockers for use on the first day of school. This list is revised annually to be accurate without any unnecessary expense, so please make all purchases before Open House on August 29.

Many supplies (scissors, glue sticks, highlighters, etc.) are provided in the classroom, but your student is welcome to bring preferred supplies (as long as they are not a distraction to classmates.) Some communal supplies are not on the list this year, but teachers may make a mid-year request for disinfectant wipes or Ziploc bags if our stockpile runs low.

Emergency Food Kit:

Each student is required to bring their own pre-assembled emergency food kit to keep in a cooler in their classroom for the school year. Please pack non-perishable food items in one gallon-size Ziploc bag with your student's name written clearly on the outside.

Examples of suggested items:

- Beef Jerky
- Whole Wheat Crackers
- Nuts & Trail Mixes
- Granola Bars
- Power/Protein Bars
- Dried Fruits
- Packs of Tuna, Salmon, Chicken, or Turkey
- You may also include a family photo with a personalized note written on the back

If there is an expiration date on an item, please make sure that the date is after June 2025. Please do not pack candy. Water will be provided by the school.
