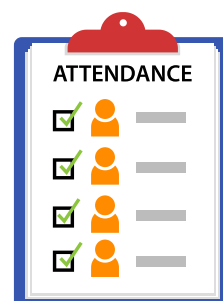


ATTENDANCE

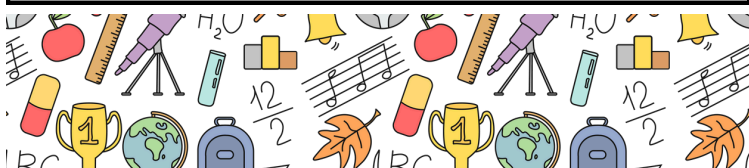
Every school day is an important academic time. Students must attend school regularly and be punctual. Parents/Guardians should make every effort to schedule appointments and family vacations around the school calendar.

Excused absences include: illness, injury, serious injury, death of a family member, medical appointments with a note from the physician, or other circumstances approved at the discretion of the principal. All other absences will be unexcused.

Parents/guardians are expected to notify the school office on the morning of the absence. For absences to be excused, a phone call, note, or email from the parent/guardian must be received within two school days to report the reason for the absence.



Missed assignments must be made up in accordance with the teacher's directions.

Tuition is due on the 5th of each month.

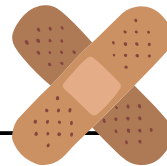

If your student has received immunizations since completing your online enrollment application in Sycamore, please provide the school office with an updated Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS).

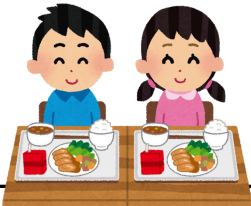
It is a Washington state law that all immunization records are on the CIS form. If you complete the form by hand the CIS needs to be signed by a healthcare professional or needs to have a printed immunization record signed by a healthcare professional.



If your student is exempt from immunizations, the school office must have a Certificate of Exemption on file.

September hot lunch orders need to be submitted by: September 2nd



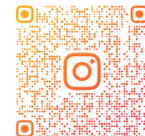
